Mr. Richmond,

On Thursday Oct 9, Riverkeeper staff collected a composite water sample from the triathlon swim route. The sample was run in triplicate for *E. coli* and all results were well below the EPA's recommended recreational swim threshold of 235 mpn (Table 1). This matches our most recent dataset for the site (Table 2). Additionally, the area and nearby cove were surveyed for cyanobacteria blooms. No indication of current or recent blooms were found. However, given the ephemeral nature of blooms in this region, we recommend visually surveying the course Saturday morning.
